#### Memorize

“And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.” Hebrews 11:6

#### REVIEW TODAY'S LESSON

FOCUS	What does it take to be a disciple? We must recognize Jesus as the promised Messiah, deny ourselves, take up our cross, and follow Him.
READ	Mark 8:27-38
ASK	Who is Jesus? What does it look like to follow Him? Who does Jesus rebuke? Why?
KEY WORDS	Messiah, disciple, rebuke, deny, adulterous, ashamed

<u>WHO?</u>	<u>WHAT?</u>	<u>WHERE? WHEN?</u>	<u>WHY?/HOW?</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Jesus</li><li>• Peter</li><li>• Disciples</li><li>• Crowd</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Jesus asks two questions – Who do <i>people</i> say I am? Who do <i>you disciples</i> say I am?</li><li>• Peter gets it right but also wrong...he says Jesus is the Messiah (right!) but he also rebukes Jesus!</li><li>• Jesus rebukes Peter for not thinking correctly</li><li>• A disciple is someone who completely surrenders their life to Jesus</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Caesarea Philippi</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Jesus is the Son of Man</li><li>• Jesus is the Messiah</li><li>• True followers of Jesus may deny themselves and be willing to live for Him no matter what</li></ul>
