#### REVIEW TODAY'S LESSON

FOCUS	What does it take to be a disciple? We must recognize Jesus as the promised Messiah, deny ourselves, take up our cross, and follow Him.
READ	Mark 9:1-13
ASK	Who is Jesus? Who stood with Jesus on Mt. Hermon? What did God say?
KEY WORDS	Transfiguration, kingdom of God, Elijah, Moses, Mt. Hermon
